

## ASA Midwest Sportsman Tire Rules

A tire rule has been implemented for the ASA Midwest Sportsman Tour in order to have orderly tech inspection on all tires permitted to be used at any event. Below, is a step by step explanation of the 2010 tire rules for the series. Please note that the ASAMST point fund is reflected upon tires purchased from the series itself. Tires purchased from an outside source do not count towards the series point fund.

Tire: Hoosier 7" 790 mounted on 8" wheels

All NEW race or practice tires must be purchased at or from the ASA Midwest Tour tire dealer. Used practice tires that are stamped from your local track can be used for practice tires at any time, however all tires will be inspected at each race to check for NEW unauthorized practice tires.

The ASAMST will institute a BANK rule for 2010 and the rule will be as follows.

All competitors will start out the season on up to 4 NEW Hoosier 790 tires that must be purchased on race day only.

Competitors may submit up to 4 used, stamped, practice tires from their local track if they choose NOT to qualify on 4 new tires the first race. Those tires will be included in your original bank. Competitors submitting used tires will only be allowed to purchase new tires that will account for 6 total tires. (ie, competitor #1 brings 3 used stamped tires and asks them to be included in his bank. That competitor will only be allowed to purchase a maximum of 3 more new tires to bring the bank total to 6.)

All Competitors that only purchased four NEW race tires will be allowed to add two more tires to their bank on opening day. Competitors can purchase up to two new tires or bring two used tires that will be scanned and included in your bank. This will give each competitor four new tires and two additional spares.

Practice Tires- Competitors can use any practice tire they want that is used. New practice tires must be purchased on race day only. All tires will be scanned for approval as practice or banked race tires.

At the 2nd event, teams will be allowed to purchase up to two more bank tires or you may submit two more used tires to be included in your bank. This will give each competitor a total of eight banked tires that can ONLY be used as race tires. Competitors can mix or match any scanned bank tire to be used as race tires. However, competitors must declare the 4 tires they will be using as "race" tires that you will qualify on and use the ENTIRE night.

Competitors that have a flat at any time can only replace that tire with a banked tire from your rotation. Competitors that have a flat on the newly purchased (1) tire prior to the feature event may be allowed to purchase (1) new tire to replace the flat tire.

Competitors that attend an event for the first time and do not have any tires may purchase up to four tires for their bank but must practice on those tires for all practice sessions. New competitors that have used tires or tires that were from their local track can submit two used tires and buy up to two new tires for that event. Competitors from local tracks may also submit 4 used, stamped tires from previous competition and are not required to buy tires at all if they chose not too.

All remaining ASAMST events will have a 1 tire maximum purchase rule. You are not required to purchase a tire at each event but you may do so to increase your bank. No competitor can sell or give another competitor a scanned tire at any time. All tires are registered to the person that is purchasing them for that individuals bank of tires.

Competitors will be randomly picked to have their tires scanned following each race at any event. The top five plus random selections will have their tires scanned after each event. Any competitor found with an unauthorized tire will automatically be disqualified from the event.
